In this case, the Indiana Court of Appeals upheld the constitutionality of the Indiana Right to Farm Act.

Todd was named as a Finalist in law for Indy's 2010 Best and Brightest. In 2011, Todd was selected by Super Lawyers as an Indiana "Rising Star." Todd is a frequent author and speaker on agricultural law and commercial real estate topics.
